

Musician Expectations

Band Hall

1. Backpacks, cell phones, and library books in the hallway along wall
2. Enter the room calmly and quietly
3. If it isn't yours, don't touch it
4. No non-band students in the band hall
5. Music stands are delicate – Do not lean or spin (made to hold 5 pounds)
6. No Drinks/Food/Gum
7. Return chair and stand to dot; walk down the aisles

Rehearsal

1. Do not talk while director is talking
2. Be in assigned chair before rehearsal starts
3. Have all materials you need before rehearsal starts
4. Mark corrections/reminders in your music with a pencil
5. Apply what you already know to different spots in the music
6. Raise your hand for questions
7. If you get lost, find your spot and jump back in
8. Be positive
9. Return instruments/supplies back to locker at the conclusion of rehearsal
 - a. Percussion:
 - Cover instruments
 - Lower timpani pedals
 - Return accessories back to cabinet

Musical

1. Play with correct posture
2. Play with correct hand position
3. Always take a full breath before playing
4. Always play with a good characteristic sound
5. Always listen and balance your part to others
6. Play with a steady pulse and precise rhythms
7. Play with the correct articulation and contrasting dynamics
