## Important Information

### Beginner Band Rehearsal - 11/19

The beginner band's next performance will be the Winter Concert on December 3rd at LBHS. Because each class will come together to perform, we will have three MANDATORY after school rehearsal in November to prepare. Those rehearsals will be on November 5, November 12, and November 19th. Please note that these dates are different than the Band Calendar handed out at the beginning of the year. Sorry for this change, but our band has grown so much that we now need a larger rehearsal space! Students need to stay after school and the rehearsal will take place in the NBMS Cafeteria from 4:00 - 5:30 pm.

If a student **MUST** miss rehearsal, your child's director must be notified at least 48 hours to the rehearsal to gain approval for the absence. These are the only chances we get to bring all of the students together and learn how our parts fit within the band, so it is crucial that all students are in attendance.

### Upcoming Assignments:

Beginners should be working on their Winter Concert music at home! Each class will be given playing assignments during school based on what sections need extra work.
