Region Band Clinic/Concert

If your student made the Region Band (as listed above), they have the Clinic and Concert on this Saturday, 11/9. The students received a letter with an itinerary in their music folder last Saturday, but here it is in case you did not see it yet: [**Region Parent Letter**](#).

- Students need to bring their instrument, their region band folder (or the music in their band binder), a pencil, and any reeds, valve oil, or other instrument maintenance items.
- Students need to arrive at Belton High School no later than 8:45 am. They can wear comfortable clothing that is IN DRESS CODE. We recommend bringing a jacket or hoodie because some of the performance spaces are typically very cold.
- Students will have lunch on their own from 12:00 until 1:15 pm. This meal is NOT provided by the directors. Students either need to pack a lunch, bring money and walk to a nearby restaurant, or have a parent pick them up and bring them to eat. Please ensure they are back by 1:15 so they are prepared to start rehearsal at 1:30 pm.
- Students will have time from 4:15 pm until 4:45 pm to change into their band uniform (black band button up shirt, black dress pants, black long socks, black shoes). They need to bring their uniform with them in the morning or have it dropped off by a parent during lunch so they are able to efficiently change and be ready for their Concert Call Time.
- Concerts begin at 5:00 with the Concert Band and then the Symphonic Band.

IMPORTANT: If your student earned a chair in the Region Band but cannot attend for whatever reason, please notify your student's director AS SOON AS POSSIBLE so the contest director can notify the alternate.

Beginner Band Rehearsal - 11/5, 11/12, 11/19

The beginner band's next performance will be the Winter Concert on December 3rd at LBHS. Because each class will come together to perform, we will have three MANDATORY after school rehearsal in November to prepare. Those rehearsals will be on November 5, November 12, and November 19th. Sorry for this change, but our band has grown so much that we now need a larger rehearsal space! Students need to stay after school and the rehearsal will take place in the NBMS Cafeteria from 4:00 - 5:30 pm.

These are the only chances we get to bring all of the students together and learn how our parts fit within the band, so it is crucial that all students are in attendance.
