Important Information

Spare Time Social - 12/20

Our next social event will take place at Spare Time on December 20th from 7:00 - 9:00 pm. Social events are always optional, but are a great opportunity for students to decompress after working hard!

PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE. Students that wish to stay with friends or family after the event is over MUST be signed out by a parent/guardian before returning to Spare Time.

Students will receive one hour of bowling, a one hour blitz game card, one round of laser tag, two pieces of pizza, and unlimited drinks. Please let a director know immediately if your student has any special dietary restrictions.

World's Finest Chocolate Fundraiser - 1/10

We are kicking off our World's Finest Chocolate Fundraiser in class on January 10th! We will be selling chocolate for two weeks and we will stop checking out boxes of chocolate on January 24th. The final date to turn in fundraiser money to count for prizes will be January 24th.

The profits earned from the World's Finest Chocolate Fundraiser will go directly towards your student's band account. This money can be used for the end-of-the-year Typhoon Texas trip or towards owed band fees. There are a few important things to remember when raising money for your student's account:

1. Each box of chocolate sold will earn \$25 towards your student's spring trip cost.
2. Funds cannot be transferred to another student except for a sibling.
3. Funds cannot roll over to another year. Any excess money earned will go towards the full band account.
4. Students can NOT use funds earned in band to go towards their trip if they choose to go on the trip with choir or orchestra. Students also cannot use choir or orchestra fundraisers to go towards their trip if they are going with band.

IMPORTANT:

The band cannot accept partially sold boxes of chocolate back after students sign out the box. When signing out a box of chocolate, the student and parent understand that they are responsible for returning the full \$60. The band and its directors are not responsible for lost/stolen/damaged products.

Fine Arts Picture Day 1/15

We will be taking band pictures on Wednesday, January 15th, during our regular class time! ALL students will take the group photo with their class and will have the option to take individual pictures upon request. An order form will be sent home with students soon so you can purchase these photos.

Students should be practicing between 10-20 minutes daily or around an hour for the entire week. The best way to ensure student success is to create a regular practice schedule with your child in a location with minimal distraction that allows for proper posture.
