Important Information

Hello band parents! We had another great week. We are getting back into our routines and every class is making music!

Forms Needed:

If you have not already done so, please go into **CutTime** and make sure you have signed the Handbook Form, BISD Extracurricular Code of Conduct Form, and Instrument Usage Agreement (if applicable). We need these forms back by this Friday, 8/23.

Everything Day Orders and Payments:

If you were unable to attend Everything Day on Saturday, August 10, your student received a paper copy of the Everything Day form. Please return this form by Friday, 8/23 with the appropriate payment. EVERYBODY needs a red band t-shirt. If your student has theirs from last year and it still fits, they do not need to purchase a new one. All students in the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Concert Band need the long-sleeve button-up shirt. If they are an 8th grader and their one from last year still fits, they do not need to purchase a new one. Students only need to pay an instrument rental fee if they are using a school-owned instrument such as oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, tenor sax, bari sax, french horn, baritone/euphonium, and tuba.

Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct

Every **STUDENT & PARENT** involved in band must sign the BISD Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct. This may be signed electronically in Cut Time by both parents and students. Students will need to follow these steps to gain access to their CutTime account:

- 1) Go to CutTime.net
- 2) Click the "Log In" button on the top right hand corner of the page
- 3) Click the button that says "Looking for CutTime Next Gen? Click here..."
- 4) Click "students" on the bottom right hand corner
- 5) Students will enter their BISD email (firstname.lastname@mybisd.net)
- 6) Click "send link"
- 7) Go to their school email account. Click on the link sent by "Cut Time Support"
- 8) Click "send verification code"
- 9) Go back to their school email account. Click on the new email sent by "Cut Time Support"
- 10) Copy the verification code that was sent. Each person will have a different code
- 11) Paste the code in the Cut Time Log In Page
- 12) Click "submit"
- 13) Click on the link that says "North Belton Middle School Band 2024-2025 Season"
- 14) Scroll down to the "documents" section. It is close to the bottom
- 15) Click where it says "BISD Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct" and electronically sign
